## SEPTIC TANK PUMPER TRUCK REGISTRATION AND INSPECTION

(Authority: California Health and Safety Code Sections 117400-117450 and Ventura County Ordinance Code Sections 4606 through 4616)

**REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Company name, city, state, and zip code displayed in letters at least 4 inches on both sides of the vehicle.
2. Ventura County Environmental Health Division Health Permit sticker must be prominently displayed.
3. Location where the liquid waste is being disposed of:  
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4. Check One:     Pumps Chemical Toilets Only                       Pumps Septic Systems  
 All companies which clean or dispose of liquid waste from septic tanks, seepage pits, or cesspools must submit pumping activity reports to the Environmental Health Division **each month**. Companies must use the "Monthly Report of Pumping Activities" form provided by this Division. All fields on the pumping activity form must be filled out completely and legibly. Improperly done or incomplete reports will be returned for correction. Failure to submit monthly pumping activity reports is a violation of the California Health and Safety Code and the Ventura County Ordinance Code and may result in permit suspension.  
 Up to date monthly reports have been submitted.

**CORRECT THE FOLLOWING:**

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**INFORMATIONAL NOTICE:**

1. Any change of company address must be reported in writing by registered mail within two days.
2. The permit is not transferable to other vehicles or to other operators and is revocable for cause.
3. SEPTIC SYSTEM REPAIR WORK REQUIREMENTS FOR THE VENTURA COUNTY UNINCORPORATED AREA.

The Ventura County Building Code states:

"No person, firm, or corporation shall erect, construct, enlarge, alter, repair, move, improve, remove, convert, demolish, equip, use, occupy, or maintain any plumbing or cause the same to be done, without first obtaining the necessary permit."
