



## **Important Notice** **Effective June 01, 2022**

On May 10th, 2022, the Ventura County Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution #22-061 declaring a Level 3 Water Shortage for Ventura County Waterworks District areas 1, 17, 19 and 38.

In order to conserve water, the referenced Resolution prohibits the filling or re-filling of swimming pools and spas. It is not the intent of the Resolution to prohibit the construction of spas and swimming pools that are already in the process of receiving a building permit prior to the effective date. Therefore, until further notice, this office will allow the issuance of a Building Permit for swimming pools and spas for which a Building Permit application has been received before June 1, 2022, but will not accept these applications after that date, to avoid the problem of constructing or repairing a pool which cannot be filled or re-filled.

The specific unincorporated areas affected by resolution #22-061 are as follows:

**Moorpark (1)**  
**Bell Canyon (17)**  
**Somis (19)**  
**Lake Sherwood (38)**

**Effective June 01, 2022, permit applications will not be accepted for:**

- 1.) New residential swimming pools and/or spas, or
- 2.) The remodel of existing residential swimming pools and/or spas requiring the removal of more than 12" of water.
