Publication of Notice for Report of Facility Information (RFI) Amendment Application

In compliance with Sections 21660. and 21660.1 of Title 27 of the California Code of Regulations, the Environmental Health Division (Division) acting as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA), and the applicant (operator), shall prepare within 5 days after the LEA approves the application and post for at least 10 days, a temporary public notice of the proposed changes to the RFI.

Description of Proposed Changes

1. The facility updated the Preliminary Closure/Preliminary Post-Closure Maintenance Plans to reflect the maximum extent of the landfill that may need closing during the entire life of the landfill; to provide dates for completion of each of the four closure phases; and to revise the post-closure maintenance cost for all capital items at least once during the 30-year post-closure period.

2. The facility updated the Non-Water Release Corrective Action Cost Estimate to reflect current unit costs; and to acknowledge that the most catastrophic scenario was identified because of detailed and comparative analyses of all possible events.
3. The facility provided an updated Water Reasonably Foreseeable Release Corrective Action Cost Estimate approved by the California Regional Water Quality Control Board.
4. The facility updated the Waste Acceptance Plan to reflect current practices (eliminating non-designated /non-hazardous contaminated soils as a waste stream); and updated the Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan to reflect current stormwater sampling requirements.

LEA Findings

The RFI Amendment was accepted on September 27, 2018 with the following findings:

1. The proposed changes are consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted California Environmental Quality Act documents in that no subsequent Environmental Impact Report (EIR) or Negative Declaration or supplemental EIR is warranted.
2. The proposed changes are acceptable and consistent with, but not limited to, State minimum standards, and including financial assurances and operating liability criteria.
3. The changes do not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current waste facilities permit.
