COVID-19 RESPONSE

The Ventura County Environmental Health Division (Division) is temporarily closed to the public as a precautionary measure to help slow the spread of COVID-19. Although our facilities are closed, we remain committed to the health and safety of our community and staff and will continue to monitor and control mosquito breeding to reduce the threat of mosquito-borne viruses.

Some Vector Control Program services may be temporarily unavailable while staff focuses on controlling mosquito breeding in public areas like gutters, flood control channels, and retention basins where we can impact the mosquito population while maintaining social distancing.
