

6. NEW BUSINESS

6a. Action: Receive a presentation from Dr. Frank P. Barajas, retired professor of United States history at California State University, Channel Islands, on

the life and legacy of labor leader and civil rights activist César Chávez in Ventura County. The presentation is the next part in the Cultural Heritage Board guest speaker series, *A Shared History: Diverse Voices Across Ventura County*.

Presentation: Chair Winters and Board Member Fernandez introduced Dr. Barajas and noted that the session is a continuation of the CHB guest speaker series, which is intended to highlight the diverse heritage of Ventura County for the benefit of both residents and visitors. Dr. Barajas presented an overview of the life and legacy of labor leader and civil rights activist César Chávez in Ventura County.

Discussion and Deliberation:

Following Dr. Barajas' presentation, a Question-and-Answer session was held with members of the audience.

6b. Action: A plaque and resolution of the Ventura County Cultural Heritage Board to be presented to outgoing member John Kulwiec in appreciation for his nearly 18 years of service.

Presentation: Dillan Murray, staff, presented draft CHB Resolution No. 2024-9 commending retiring Board Member Kulwiec who served 2007-2025. Tricia Maier, staff, presented a plaque as a token of appreciation to Board Member Kulwiec.

Discussion and Deliberation:

Board Members noted their thanks and appreciation for Board Member Kulwiec's many years of service.

Board Member Fernandez made a motion to adopt CHB Resolution No. 2024-9. Board Member Gooch seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0.

7a. Board Member Reports

Chair Winters reported on the luncheon held at the Scarlett/McGrath Ranch (5011 West Gonzales Road, Oxnard) by property owner Beverlee McGrath to celebrate it being listed in the National Register of Historic Places.

Board Member Kulwiec reported on the status of the Santa Paula homeless shelter. The Rotary Club of Santa Paula will be gifting presents to children who live at the shelter.

Board Member Fernandez reported on the success of the Scarlett/McGrath Ranch luncheon event and his desire that some type of oral or visual documentary be produced on property owner Beverlee McGrath and her interesting life. Board Member Fernandez stated that he would reach out to some amateur filmmakers to gauge interest in such a project.

Board Member Angelini reported that the Ronald Reagan Presidential Library & Museum has a temporary exhibit featuring the Dead Sea Scrolls, which is the first time they've been on the west coast.

7b. CHB Program Updates from Staff

Dillan Murray, staff, reported that the next regularly scheduled hearing will be on December 23rd, if there are items to be reviewed.

Next, Mr. Murray reported that the Washington Elementary School in the City of Ventura was nominated to the National Register by the San Buenaventura Conservancy. The State Historical Resources Commission will review the nomination at their February 7th quarterly meeting. The meeting can be attended via Zoom on the commission's website, if interested.

Finally, Mr. Murray reported that one expected item to be reviewed by the CHB in the near future is a proposed historic district in the Santa Monica Mountains area near Malibu encompassing a property formerly owned by artist Anthony Duquette as well as a related neighboring property.
